Incentives are limited to the Manufacturers Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) of the product including taxes and shipping up to the incentive cap. Incentive amounts are based on \$500 per acre-foot (325,851.43 gallons) of water saved. Incentive caps for each device are described below. The incentive is paid up front based on pricing documentation.

## F) TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Participation in the Accelerated Public Sector (PSP) program is limited to public agencies on a first come, first served basis, must be within MWD service area, and must be approved by MWD and it's respective member agency.
- A partnering public agency cannot receive a rebate from the Save A Buck program for the same device that is being funded through PSP.
- Public Agencies requesting participation must have a combined minimum Annual Water Usage of 50 acre-feet ( 16,292,571 gallons ) in order to qualify.
- Upon approval of the Incentive application, an up-front financial assistance is provided to the partnering public agency to purchase PSP Program approved water efficient devices. The incentive pays up to the incentive cap and includes tax and shipping. It is recommended that the partnering public agency submit the application and receive the incentive prior to purchase of the devices in order to ensure approval is received.
- Incentives are limited to the Manufacturers' Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) of the product including taxes and shipping up to the incentive cap. Incentive amounts are based on \$500 per acre-foot of water saved. The incentive is paid up front based on pricing documentation.
- Partnering public agency is responsible for procurement of devices, installation & installation costs, and maintenance of devices.
- After completion of installation, partnering public agency will be required to submit sales receipts as a proof of purchase. Receipts must include quantity, make, and model of the devices installed. A reconciliation between the incentives funded, actual procurement, and proof of installation will take place. A partnering public agency will refund, if any, to MWD any unspent funds within a specific time frame.
- All devices for which an incentive is issued are subject to an on-site installation verification inspection. If device installation cannot be verified, the partnering public agency will reimburse the program for the funds received including all associated processing costs. Access to the funded device(s) must be provided.
- Devices must be purchased on or after August 21, 2007.
- Facilities using RECYCLED WATER may not qualify. Call 1-800-423-9896 to verify eligibility.
- Confirm that devices being installed qualify for the incentive program by calling 1-800-423-9896 prior to purchase.
- Incentives or Rebates are issued once per lifetime of the property for each eligible area. Site may be subject to pre-inspection prior to issuance of rebate.
