

HOME IS WHERE THE SAVINGS ARE.

- High-efficiency toilets can save up to 12,000 gallons/year
- Shorter showers can save 2.5 gallons/minute or more
- Turning off water when brushing teeth can save up to 2 gallons/minute

Lawn & Garden

- Soil moisture sensors save about 13,000 gallons/year
- Rain barrels save about 50 gallons/large rain storm
- Turf Removal saves about 34 gallons/year/square foot
- High-efficiency sprinkler nozzles save about 850 gallons/year
- Weather-based irrigation controllers save 13,000 gallons/year

Kitchen/Laundry

- Faucet aerators save 1.5 gallons/minute
- Full load of dishes save 2 – 4.5 gallons/load
- High-efficiency clothes washers can save up to 11,000 gallons/year
