

# Use these Example Plans

On the following pages, we have included garden plan examples of **Front** and **Back** yards in the North and South coast climates as well as for Inland areas. A **Master Plant List** has been provided that you can use to substitute for the plants suggested on each of the plans (see p. ). For example, take note of the plant number on the plan (**1-17**) and consult the **Master Plant List** for alternative selections.

## Example Plan A



The **Planting Plans** take into consideration the regional climate, such as Coastal or Inland, the microclimates on the particular property, and the proposed contouring such as berms and basins (see p.41) substituted using the Master List.

The **Contouring and Hydrozone Plans** show how rainwater generated from the roofs of the buildings will be captured and held on the property for the benefit of the plants, and how the plants need to be hydrozoned efficiently.



- 1** Blue for **MODERATE** water use,
- 2** Yellow for **LOW** water use, and
- 3** Red for **VERY LOW** water use.

 The **Butterfly** icon indicates plants that support the life cycle of pollinators, butterflies and other insects.

Wherever we have provided plant selections, we identify them by their water requirements by placing their identification numbers on a colored background. You can use this color coding to help you group plants by their water requirements in your new landscape, making it easier to irrigate them properly.
