

## About the **Program**

Metropolitan offers free in-person and virtual indoor and outdoor water use surveys for residential properties. These surveys offer homeowners recommendations to reduce water waste and make their homes more efficient. Surveys are scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis. Apply as soon as possible since funding is limited.

## Eligibility

The survey is conducted with the assistance of the homeowner.
The property may only receive one survey for the life of the program and must be located within Metropolitan's service area.

## What to **Expect**

For virtual surveys, homeowners will need to have an electronic device such as a phone or tablet to communicate with the certified landscape auditor. For in-person surveys, homeowners or someone over the age of 18 must be present. The auditor will train the homeowner or landscape contractor during the site visit.

### In addition, the survey will feature:

- Indoor device information: make, model, age, water factor, and water use
- Rebate information

- Evaluation of water meter to check for leaks
- Irrigation controller and zone/station information
- Review of issues that contribute to higher water use, such as valve malfunctions, high or low pressure, sprinkler misalignment, poor draining, breaks and leaks, and runoff
