### Salvia clevelandii Cleveland Blue Sage


The Cleveland Sage is a perennial shrub that grows 4' tall and wide. It has fragrant gray foliage and blue, lavender or white flowers that bloom between May and August. This shrub needs full sun and prefers well drained soil..








## Anigozanthos 'Big Red' Big Red Kangaroo Paws

'Big Red' is a perennial with dark green, smooth, sword-like evergreen leaves. It produces spikes of striking, fuzzy, tubular, red flowers that look like claws, attracting hummingbirds. Flowers bloom from late spring to fall.













### **Moonshine Yarrow**

Long, straight stems with pale yellow flowers are striking on the mats of green to gray-green leaves of this plant, which are flatter and less divided than those of the Achillea millefolium. This Yarrow propagates easily from rooted cuttings or








### Penstemon heterophyllus 'Margarita Bop' Margarita Bop Foothill Penstemon

This is one of the easiest and most versatile California native plants. This is a hybrid Penstemon, which will produce beautiful, purple blue flowers through much of the year when spent flowers are removed.











## Calylophus hartwegii Hartwegs Sundrops

This low-growing perennial has bright green leaves and large, yellow flowers that bloom spring through summer. Its a great choice for a rock garden or rocky slope and is drought tolerant once established.










### Lavandula stoechas

#### **Spanish Lavender**

This dense shrub grows 2'-3' tall with blue gray foliage and deep purple flowers that have large showy bracts near the top of the spikes. It is drought tolerant .












### **Apricot Mallow**

This native shrub has a relaxed sprawling form. It usually has light orange flowers but can be white, pink or purple. Leaves are small, grayish green, and 3 lobed. This extremely drought and soil tolerant shrub does best in full sun.

#### Mexican Palo Verde


