

Ceanothus griseus hor. 'Yankee Point'

Yankee Point California Lilac

Yankee Point is a fast growing shrub that stays near 3' in height with a spread of 8'-12'. It has large, bright green, evergreen leaves. During spring, light blue flowers cover the plant. 'Yankee Point' is great for banks and mass plantings. It does well on the coast and tolerates full sun but needs afternoon shade and extra watering during summer in hot inland areas. It attracts hummingbirds, butterflies and beneficial insects
